### The Top 50 Shag Songs of 2007

nce again the Association of Beach and Shag Club DeeJays is publishing its Top 50 Shag Songs of the past year. This list is compiled from the members who chose to rate the music of the past year, based on what they see filling the floor and requests received wherever they DJ or attend a shag event. Points are assigned based on how many DJs submitted the song on their list and where they rated it. Then a simple numerical calculation determines which songs accumulated the most points and those songs make the top 50 in order based on those points. This is not a list of the top 50 new songs of the year, but of those shag songs that people are dancing to across the region. We also do not rate slow songs or line dance songs, although they may be played for shaggers to dance to.

s always, this list is dedicated to the memory of Charlie Byrd (Carawan) and his syndicated radio show, the Charlie Byrd Beach Blast. Charlie Byrd, with his vast knowledge of beach and shag music, was a role model for many within our association until his death from cancer.

his year's Top 50 Shag Songs set a couple of records. First, we had the largest number of DJs that we have ever had participating in 2007 by sending in their individual Top 50 lists, a total of 34 DJs. And we had the largest number of total songs submitted, a total of 584 different songs, indicating how many different songs are being played and are popular across the area where our music is played.

n 2006 there was a runaway song for first place, but this year there were three songs that far surpassed all the others in the voting. These songs, "My Big Sister's Radio" by the Mighty Mike Schermer Band, "Crazy" by Gnarls

Barkley and "Rhythm" by the Inmen and the Impressions, accounted for a total of 19 of the first place votes on the 34 lists submitted.

everal artists had more than one song nominated and six actually had more than one song make the final list. Congratulations to Gary Brown for having three of his songs make the Top 50, while Paul Craver, Craig Woolard, Rick Strickland, Danny Brooks and Rickey Godfrey had two each. Also, this year we had 31 songs that repeated from the Top 50 Shag Songs of 2006.

he oldest song to make the list this year, once again, was "I Used to Cry Mercy Mercy" by the Lamplighters, released in 1954. Other classic songs that continue to make the list included "Come Get To This" by Marvin Gaye, "Lady Soul" by the Temptations, and "Give Me You" by Billy Ward and the Dominoes.

e hope you enjoy looking over this list and that you will see many of your favorites from the past year. We also hope you will support those DJs listed on the back page, who took the time to put together their list of the Top 50 Songs of the year to help make this final Top 50 of the ABSCDJs possible.
